

RESOLUTION No. 2014-08

A RESOLUTION OF MONROE TOWNSHIP,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ADOPTING MONROE TOWNSHIP'S
SIGN MAINTENANCE POLICY

WHEREAS, a revision to the 2009 Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) requires the maintenance of minimum retroreflectivity standards for traffic control signs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to not only memorialize its new retroreflectivity signage standard but to also devise and implement a plan to replace signs that do not meet the new retroreflectivity standard, and wishes to formally do so by this resolution.

WHEREAS, local public agencies have until May 2014 to establish and implement a sign assessment and management method to maintain minimum levels of sign retroreflectivity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MONROE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, MONROE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA:

SECTION 1. Monroe Township hereby adopts the following Monroe Township Sign Maintenance policy:

- i. All new or replacement road signs installed in Monroe Township from the date of this resolution forward must meet the minimum retroreflectivity standards as indicated in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2009, or as revised.
- ii. Monroe Township shall adopt a Map system for the purpose of identifying a sign maintenance replacement program to ensure the Township is in compliance with the latest MUTCD minimum retroreflectivity requirements. Replacement as budget allows.
- iii. Monroe Township shall annually conduct a tour of its roads for the purpose of eventually creating a complete inventory of its public road signs, with such inventory noting for each sign, its location, type, general condition and sheeting type per guidelines.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any provision of this resolution is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
