ZONING/BUILDING:

A zoning and/or building permit shall be required prior to the erection, addition, alteration, use or change of use of any building or structure including grading and driveway resurfacing operations. A permit is required for the placement, removal or replacement of mobile homes and pre-constructed building. A driveway permit is required for new driveway installations. A highway occupancy permit is required for any work within the Township rights-of-way.

Failure to secure a permit prior to commencing any of the above constitutes a violation of the Monroe Township Zoning Ordinance.
