A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE UPDATED MONROE TOWNSHIP
EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

WHEREAS, Monroe Township (“Township”) has prepared an Emergency Operations Plan, in order to protect the lives and property of the residents of the Township in the event of an emergency, terrorism, or other disaster, whether such event is natural or human-caused.

WHEREAS, 35 Pa. C.S. § 7101 et seq. mandates that the Township prepare, maintain and keep current a disaster emergency management plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by disaster, prompt and effective response to disaster and disaster emergency relief and recovery in consonance with the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Plan.

WHEREAS, the Township has prepared an Emergency Operations Plan for consideration by the Township Board of Supervisors, said Plan having been revised August 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned Township Board of Supervisors do hereby approve, adopt, and effectuate the Township Emergency Operations Plan, said Plan being reviewed biennially to make certain that it conforms to the requirements of the Cumberland County Emergency Guideline.


