RESOLUTION 2019-11

RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND ESTABLISHING A DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING PERSONNEL POLICY FOR MONROE TOWNSHIP IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL OMNIBUS TRANSPORTATION EMPLOYEES TESTING ACT OF 1991.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township to adopt and establish a drug and alcohol personnel policy for Monroe Township in compliance with the requirements of the Federal Omnibus Transportation Employees Testing Act of 1991, the regulations of the U.S. Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follow:

SECTION 1: ADOPTION

Monroe Township hereby adopts in its entirety the "Monroe Township CDL Employee Drug and Alcohol Testing Personnel Policy" substantially in the forms referred to in Section 2 hereinbelow.

SECTION 2: DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY AND FORMS

The Monroe Township Drug and Alcohol Testing Personnel Policy and forms shall be substantially in the forms presented to Monroe Township at the September 12, 2019 Board of Supervisors meeting, which forms are approved. Copies of the Monroe Township CDL Employee Drug and Alcohol Testing Personnel Policy and forms, in the forms so presented to this meeting and so approved, shall be filed with the Secretary of Monroe Township and shall be made available for inspection at reasonable times to interested persons requesting such inspection.

SECTION 3: IMPLEMENTATION

Monroe Township, and its authorized personnel and representatives, shall implement all the terms and conditions set forth in the Monroe Township CDL Employee Drug and Alcohol Testing Personnel Policy and the forms associated therewith.

SECTION 4: RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER RESOLUTIONS

The provisions of this Resolution, so far as they are the same as those of Resolutions in force immediately prior to the enactment of this Resolution, are intended as a continuation of such Resolutions and not as new enactments. Provisions of this Resolution shall not affect any act done or liability incurred, nor shall it affect any suite or prosecution pending or to be instituted to enforce any right of penalty or to punish any offense under the authority of any Resolution repealed by this Resolution.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY

In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution or other Resolutions affected by this Resolution, it being the intent of Monroe Township that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: REPEALER

All other Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are expressly repealed.


