RESOLUTION NO. 2020-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MONROE TOWNSHIP
ADOPTING THE TAPPING FEES ESTABLISHED BY THE MONROE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Monroe Township Board of Supervisors (hereinafter referred to as the "Board of Supervisors") desires to adopt the tapping fees.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is to update the current tapping fees for the northern and southern sewer districts of Monroe Township, which were set pursuant to Monroe Township Resolution 2006-10.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The tapping fee for the connection in the Northern District shall be \$5,900.00 per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU), plus other charges to include, but not necessarily being limited to, the actual connection fee and customer facilities fee.
2. The tapping fee for the connection in the Southern District shall be \$4,016.25 per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU), plus other charges to include, but not necessarily being limited to, the actual connection fee and customer facilities fee.
3. The tapping fees for connection in the Northern District and in the Southern District were determined by Pennoni Associates by their letter dated February 19, 2020, along with attachments, same being attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein. The calculations addressed and included, among other things, three component parts, being generally referred to as the capacity, collection and conveyance components.

4. This Resolution and the tapping fees for connections established hereunder shall become effective July 1, 2020.




